CONSCIOUS SEDATION

Post-Operative Care Instructions

After Sedation Instructions for You & Your child

- A responsible person should be with your child until he/she has fully recovered from the effects of the sedation. (Typically 12-18 hours)
- Your child should not go up and down stairs unattended. Let your child stay on the ground floor until fully recovered.
- Your child should begin eating appropriate food as soon as allowed, based on procedure post-operative instructions. Do not delay.
- Your child needs to drink plenty of fluids as soon as possible and remain hydrated.
- Your child may seem alert when he/she leaves. This may be misleading so do not leave your child unsupervised for 12 hours after surgery.
- Always hold your child's arm when walking the day of surgery.
- Your child should not be left alone with other children for a period of no less than 24 hours after the last dosage of medication.
- Under no circumstances should your child take sedatives or stimulants for 24 hours after the appointment.
